

Royce Watson Memorial Hanmer Rally 2014 Supported By Stadium Cars

SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS: PART ONE

1. JURISDICTION

This event is a National Clubman's Rally, promoted by the Autosport Club Inc of Christchurch and will take place on **Saturday 6th September 2014** in the Hanmer Forest Estate.

The Rally will be held under these Supplementary Regulations, the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules particularly Appendix Three, Schedule R being the Standing Regulations for all Rallies and Appendix Two, Schedule A – Driver and Vehicle Safety Requirements.

3. THE EVENT

3.1 Venue: The rally will be run in the Hanmer Forest Estate, Hanmer Springs, North Canterbury. The Service Park is on Jollies Pass Road, Hanmer Springs, and the Rally HQ is at the Hot Springs Motor Lodge, 35 Hanmer Springs Rd Hanmer Springs.

3.2 Length: The rally comprises 78 km's of special stages and approx 70 km's of touring. All Special Stages are on good gravel roads. A full stage description and confirmed distances will be attached with acceptance of entry.

3.3 First Car Starts: From Rally HQ at 11.00 hrs Saturday 6th September 2014

3.4 First Car Finishes: At (approx) 16.30 hrs Saturday 6th September 2014, at the final control which is situated at the Five Stags Restaurant and Bar, 35 Hanmer Springs Rd, Hanmer Springs.

4. ENTRIES

4.1 Opening and Closing: Entries are open now, and close at 1800 hrs on **Wednesday 27th August 2014**. **Late entries will close at the organiser's discretion. Please note that priority entry will be given to the competitors who had entered last year's event. This priority entry will cease 21 days after the Reg's are released.**

4.2 Entry Acceptance: Entries shall be made on the correct form and to be deemed valid must be complete in all details and accompanied by the appropriate fees. Acceptance will be at the organising committee's discretion. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the prescribed provisions of the National Sporting Code.

4.3 Fees: (1) Competing Vehicle:

Fee if paid by 27th August 2014 \$345.00 including GST,

Late Entries. \$400.00 including GST,

Last years entrants are entitled to a \$50 reduction if their entry is received within the 21-day priority period.

Service Crew: There is no fee to register one service crew.

Withdrawals notified by Wed 3rd September 2014 may receive a 70% refund.

4.4 Number of Starters: The organisers reserve the right to abandon the event if fewer than 35 entries are received at normal closing date. The maximum number of starters will be 50. Any additional entries received will be placed on the reserve list in order of receipt.

4.5 Acceptance of Entry:

These will be emailed no later than Thursday 4th September 2014, together with the seeded start list.

4.6 Competitor Requirements:

(1) Knowledge and Understandings: In signing the entry forms, competitors (Entrant and Drivers) are deemed to fully understand the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules, particularly:

- (a)** The National Sporting Code articles pertaining to protests and competitors' obligations, and
- (b)** Appendix Three Schedule R articles pertaining to Stage notes, Pace notes and Reconnaissance.

(2) Licence Requirements: Both the No. 1 and No. 2 drivers shall hold a National Rally Grade or higher MotorSport NZ issued Competition Licence. If the Entrant is other than a driver, an Entrant's licence in the name of the Entrant is required.

(3) New Competitors: Any driver(s) who have not previously competed in three or more rallies must attend the new competitor special briefing. This does include the other driver or co driver of the crew. Details of venue and time will be announced with the acceptance of entry.

(4) Special award: There will be a special award for the highest-placed driver who is and admits to being over 50 years old, and who competes in a two-wheel drive car in the event.

5. ELIGIBLE VEHICLES

5.1 Compliance: All vehicles shall comply with Appendix Two Schedule A and Appendix Three Schedule R of the current MotorSport Manual unless stated otherwise in these supplementary regulations.

5.2 Classes: Vehicles will be divided into the following classes:

*	Class A	0-1300cc
*	Class B	1301 – 1600cc
*	Class C	1601 and over 2WD
*	Class D	4WD

6. DOCUMENTATION AND SCRUTINEERING AUDIT

Competitors must present themselves at documentation for the checking of licences and documents, issuing of competition numbers and applicable advertising material prior to presenting the car for audit scrutineering and for those cars with forced induction engines, turbo restrictor inspection.

Competitors may have their car scrutineered by their own Club Scrutineer prior to the event, as long as their Log Book is clearly notated.

Cars will not be cleared to compete until all of these numbers and advertising requirements are firmly affixed in the appropriate places on the vehicle.

The venue and your actual report time to documentation will be advised in your acceptance of entry.

10. RESULTS

Provisional results will be posted at the Five Stags Restaurant and Bar (Formally Hot Springs Hotel), in Hanmer Springs, at approx 1900 hours on Saturday 6^h September 2014

11. STAGE NOTES

The use of Stage Notes is not permitted throughout this Event.

12. SERVICING

Servicing will only be permitted within the confines of the designated service area on Jollies Pass Road, Hanmer Springs, although pre-event under bonnet checks may be carried out at the Start venue. NO Service

vehicles are permitted in the Hotel Car park. There are penalties for servicing elsewhere. No service vehicles are permit to go into the forest to recover competition vehicle. Please do not leave any mess behind!

13. RE-JOINING

Any competitor may temporarily withdraw from the rally to effect repairs and rejoin, under the following provisions.

The competitor must complete the Temporary Withdrawal form from the rear of the Road Book, and hand to a Control Official or Competitor Relations Officer. After repairs have been completed, the competitor may apply to rejoin the rally by completing the Rejoining Form and handing to the Control Official. If the application is granted, the competitor will be permitted to restart at a Stage that starts after the normal service times of the event.

Any competitor/s rejoining the event will not be classified as completing the event and will not feature in the final results as a finisher.

No competitor will be permitted to restart the rally once they have handed in a 'Final Withdrawal' form.

14. SOCIAL AND PRIZEGIVING

The venue is the Five Stags Restaurant and Bar (formally the Hot Springs Hotel) 35 Hanmer Springs Rd, there will be a superb meals available as always from 6.30 pm. After the results are final, there will be a prize giving during the evening. It should be a great evening as usual.
