## Darfield Autocross

January 22<sup>nd</sup> 2023

### Supplementary Regulations

#### 1. JURISDICTION

This event is a ClubSport Basic Autocross, promoted by Autosport Car Club and will take place on Sunday January 22<sup>nd</sup> 2023 at Auchenflower Rd, Darfield, Canterbury.

The Meeting will be held under these Supplementary Regulations, the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its Appendices and Schedules particularly:

- Appendix Five, Schedule C being the Standing Regulations for all ClubSport Events and,
- Appendix Two, Schedule A –Driver and Vehicle Safety Requirements.

#### 3. EVENT DESCRIPTION:

##### 3.1 The course is on a grass paddock with gentle hills.

##### 3.2 **Directions:** From Darfield continue on main West Coast Road for approximately 6.3km, turn left into Auchenflower Road. Follow this to the intersection of Deans Road (approximately 3 km). Cross over Deans Road and continue to signposted gate on the left.

##### 3.3 **Classes:** Vehicles will be divided into the following classes:

Class 1: 2WD 0 – 1300cc

Class 2: 2WD 1301 – 1600cc

Class 3: 2WD 1601cc +

Class 4: 4WD

Class 5: Road Car (no rally tyres)

Class X: Crosskart or Cross Car (not eligible for overall results or Autosport Club Championship).

## 4. ENTRIES

- 4.1 Entries can only be made through the MotorSport Online system

Any entry will not be deemed valid until internet payment is received.

Double entry drivers will be accepted at the discretion of the Clerk of Course with single entry drivers given priority.

Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the prescribed provisions of the National Sporting Code.

### 4.2 Opening and Closing Dates:

Entries open with the publication of these regulations and close at 5pm Friday 20<sup>th</sup> January 2023.

## 5. COMPETITOR REQUIREMENTS and UNDERSTANDING:

### 5.1 Licence Requirements:

A competition or civil drivers license is not required.

Any competitor between the ages of 12 – 16 years of age must have a parent/guardian sign the indemnity form.

### 5.2 Competitor Understanding:

In submitting the entry competitors (Entrant and Drivers) are deemed to fully understand the MotorSport NZ National Sporting Code and its relevant Appendices and Schedules. In particular:

- The National Sporting Code Articles pertaining to protests and competitors obligations, and
- Appendix Five, Schedule C.

- 5.3 A minimum of 100% cotton or approved flame proof overalls must be worn and a Motorsport NZ approved helmet must be worn. All competitors shall wear safety apparel in compliance with [Appendix Two, Schedule A](#) of the Motorsport NZ Manual suitable for a Clubsport Basic event.

## 6. ELIGIBLE VEHICLES

- 6.1 **Compliance:** Car must meet [Schedule A of the Motorsport NZ Manual](#) or be of WOF standard.

## 7. DOCUMENTATION & SCRUTINEERING AUDIT INSPECTION

- 7.1 **8:30 – 9:45am Documentation & Scrutineering Audit Inspection:** Will be held at the venue.
- 7.2 **10am Drivers Briefing:** Attendance by all drivers is compulsory – a roll call will be taken and failure to attend will result in a penalty.

## 8. GENERAL INFORMATION

- 8.1 Results: Fastest run of each course accumulated.
- 8.2 Prize Giving: At venue after event clean up.
- 8.3 Runs: 1 Indian File per course. Up to 3 runs per course. Course can run both clockwise and anticlockwise directions. Clerk of Course has the right to abandon any run and results will be on last final run.
- 8.4 Lining Up: Cars will run at about 1-minute intervals and in numerical order. Start order may be staggered in the interests of fairness.
- 8.5 Damage: Competitors are liable for any damage they may cause to property, fences, club gear and equipment.
- 8.6 Refund Policy: No refunds will be issued once documentation has been completed.
- 8.7 Alcohol is not permitted to be consumed by any competitor, or their crew, at the event before, or during, the days competition.
- 8.8 Passengers are not allowed to be taken in road cars. Passengers may only be carried in cars which have been checked and approved to do so and with Motorsport NZ approved full rollcages and full harnesses restraints. Passengers must sign the indemnity form.
- 8.9 All passengers must be 12 years of age or older and must sign indemnity form before being allowed into a competing vehicle.
